- We have provided limbs for children in 23 states
- As of June 2014, the Limb Bank had \$34,025.94 worth of components
- As of June 2014, we have \$63,882.77 remaining in the Myoelectric Limb Project
- 5 children were fitted from 1/2013 to 6/2014
- Since October 1<sup>st</sup> we've had two requests, 1 approved, 1 waiting.

Carrie Davis delighted us with her attendance. Carrie was the first recipient of the Margarete Golding Award from IIW, for her work with children who've lost a limb.

The families were grateful for the help given through the Foundation. Arath's father stated he goes to his son's school everyday at lunch time to make sure Arath does not pick up anything too hot for his hand to hold.

Will Yule gave a presentation on his role with Hanger and the work he does for children in the State of Arizona, through Children's Rehabilitative Services.

The Foundation trustees and Governing Body, and guests were delighted to meet the children and their families.
