

Inner Wheel U.S.A. Strategic Plan

Vision: Inner Wheel U.S.A. provides the mechanism for members to support humanitarian and social causes at local, regional, national, and international levels. It connects a network of members with the same focus and desire in order to pool mutual resources and talents.

Mission Statement: The mission of Inner Wheel U.S.A. is to unify and support the Clubs and Districts throughout the United States in fulfilling the objects of Inner Wheel by: (1) Fostering Unity among the Clubs, (2) Strengthening and expanding Inner Wheel throughout the United States, (3) Supporting the work of the Inner Wheel U.S.A. Foundation, and (4) To support the goals and objects of International Inner Wheel.

Objects: Inner Wheel U.S.A. objects are to promote true friendship, to encourage the ideals of personal service, and to foster international understanding.

Goals:

Membership: Inner Wheel U.S.A. is an organization with its Members and Clubs committed to friendship, supporting the Inner Wheel U.S.A. Foundation, increasing membership and clubs, and participating in community service.

Communication: Inner Wheel U.S.A. fosters the Vision, Mission, Objects, and Service of its Members and Clubs. It encourages communication among local, national, and international Inner Wheel Clubs to share ideas and goals. Communication with the local Rotary District and Rotary Clubs (in the geographic location of the members), the business community, and the public is also encouraged.

Structure: Inner Wheel U.S.A. is comprised of a Governing Body to make policy and disseminate information on activities of Inner Wheel Clubs, Districts, National, and International levels.

Rotary/Inner Wheel Connection: Inner Wheel U.S.A. partners with Rotary whenever possible. The exchange of newsletters and invitations to Inner Wheel events with the local Rotary Club Presidents and the District Governor should be promoted.

Recognition: Inner Wheel U.S.A. encourages all past and present national officers to be recognized for outstanding contributions to Inner Wheel U.S.A. This would be in effect at the Club, District, and National Levels. Make use of the Past Presidents as a resource for mentoring, to identify qualified members for National Board offices, for getting members qualified to hold future offices, and to work with Inner Wheel strategic planning. Inner Wheel Clubs are encouraged to work toward and be recognized for outstanding service by the Inner Wheel U.S.A. Club Year of Achievement Award.

Community Service: Inner Wheel U.S.A. supports its clubs in their individual community service projects.

Inner Wheel U.S.A. Foundation: Encourage ALL Inner Wheel members in becoming yearly contributors to the Inner Wheel U.S.A. Foundation. Solicit grants and other sources of financial support outside the organization to help fund the Myoelectric Limb Project and to enable Hanger Clinic to serve and benefit more children.
