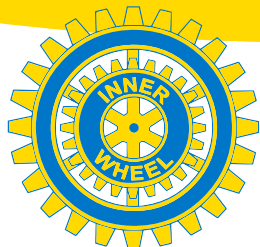

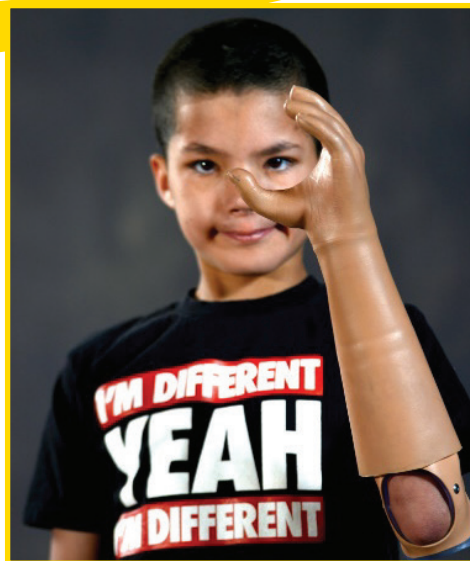

# Possibilities Abound

Inner Wheel USA created this Foundation to provide funding for children through its partnership with Hanger Clinic.

The IWUSA Foundation provides myoelectric limbs to children under the age of 18 years who were born without an arm or hand or who have lost an arm or hand through accident or disease.

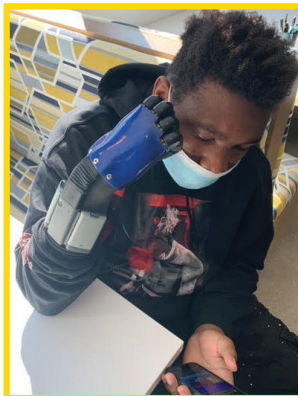
Hanger Clinic works with the Foundation in identifying and evaluating potential limb recipients and fits, educates and trains children in the use of their prostheses through their over 800 clinics nationwide.

Our Foundation also sponsors Camp No Limits which provides therapeutic camps for young people with limb loss and limb difference and their families.

As a 501(c)(3) organization, all donations are tax deductible.



Active **ISABELLA** wears her passive prostheses every day to play with her siblings since she was one year old. At 2½, she will soon be fitted with a new myoelectric arm.



**PERCY**, from Illinois, is 14 and lost his fingers in a fireworks accident. He was fitted with a Touch Bionic I-Limb and now enjoys playing football, basketball, and video games.
